Attendance

One of our priorities this year will be to monitor attendance and timekeeping carefully as they are proved to be the main factors affecting children's progress and achievement. Parents/Carers can now use an online form and should register with "myaccount" to access this. This can be found at https://www.glasgow.gov.uk/pupilabsence

Absences should be reported before 09.30 each day. Parents/carers can continue to call the absence line and the absence line telephone number is 0141 287 0039.

Children should only be collected early when a prior arrangement has been made with management. Attendance should never fall below 95% unless in exceptional circumstances.
