and to celebrate the life of your Church.

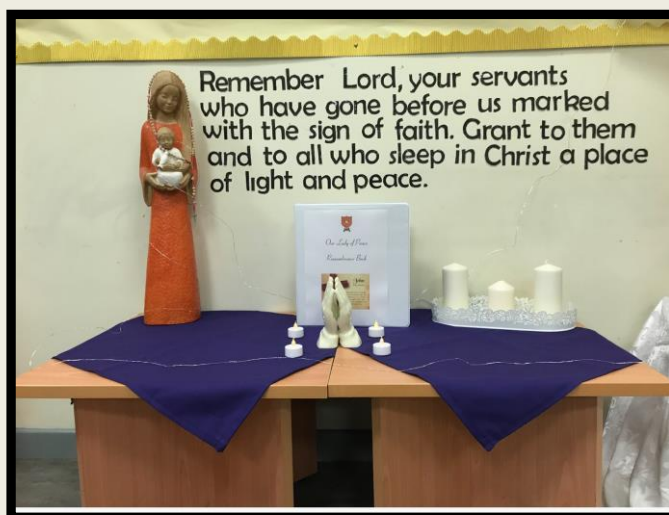
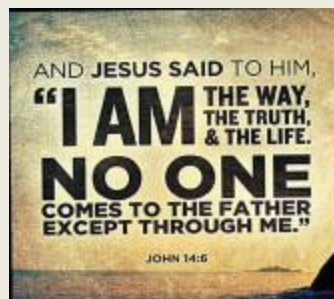
Help us to grow in holiness
