#### Science Centre

## **Uniforms**

Please encourage your child to wear the full uniform. There are some non-uniform items being worn regularly (joggers, leggings, fashion items). Your support in helping us avoid high standards from slipping is appreciated. Fashion items are to be discouraged. We hope to have reduced cost uniform items for sale, at our next Parents' Evening.

## Health & Safety matters

Some clarification: false nails, acrylic nails and lengthy nails are not permitted for school. They may compromise safety for both the child wearing them and peers. As is the case with earrings, jewellery, particular hair adornments, etc. such nails are not for school and participation in PE will be compromised.

## World Book Day

We have decided to focus more on children creating rather than dressing to maximise the literacy element and hopefully minimise costs to parents and families. The aim is to have some form of 'gallery' to celebrate the children's work. Every child will receive a token equivalent to £1 off the purchase of a book, as provided by the World Book Day organisation. Ask your child what is in store...stories, cookies, juice and much more!

#### P.E Kits

Sadly, a substantial number of children in almost all classes, are not changing for PE and/bringing a PE kit to school. I aim to start an award for the class which has most children wearing PE kit over a set timescale, e.g. 4-6 weeks. This may give an incentive to bring PE kits to school and the children will all work as a team to get the prize. We really need your help in this area and I ask that you ensure your child has a PE kit on the correct days.
