Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope you are all managing to avoid what seems to be a rise in Covid-19 cases. Our Lady of Peace, like some other schools, is experiencing high levels of both staff and child absence due to testing positive. In spite of this, we are managing to maintain continuity of teaching and learning, as our priority for the children.

Covid-19

Our arrangements for entry and 3pm exit must be respected and almost all parents are helping us with this. Your support in keeping everyone safe is very much appreciated, thank you.

Reminder: no one should attend school if symptomatic/feel unwell with suspected Covid-19 and he/she should notify the school as soon as possible Please:

- Keep a distance from others when in the school playground at the drop off and pick up times.
- Reduce footfall: e.g. One person only should collect a child/children, if safe to do so.
- ➤ Wait in the playground at the allocated areas only. A clear path must be left for the P4 children to get to the gate.
- Continue wait outside the gates for P4-7 children
- ➤ Leave the playground and school gate areas immediately after your child has been collected.
- Email/call the school if you have a query and we will do everything we can to help. Engaging the staff in conversations in the playground is a risk to both you and the staff member.
- Avoid going to the office/main entrance as the school is closed to adults unless a visit has been prearranged by the Headteacher.
- ➤ Keep to the school day 9am-3pm unless you have an urgent appointment.

Breakfast Club

This opens from 8.00am-8.45am. The last entry is 8.35am. The children attending must take breakfast and behave safely. The Breakfast Club is staffed by Cordia staff and not teaching staff.

Sacraments

Our Primary 3 children will receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation on Saturdays of 19th and 26th March at 10.00am at St Jude's Parish. Please keep them in your prayers and thank you for helping with their preparations.

School Lunches – Pre-Ordering – Meal Selection

Hopefully, you have already activated your ParentPay account. However, if you have not already done so, please do so as soon as possible. Advice has already been issued but is on our website too.

All lunches must be paid for and pre-ordered via ParentPay.

You will be able to order meals until 8.00am each morning or alternatively, you can order up to four weeks in advance.

Meal selection should be available to you from 6pm on Tuesday 22 March 2022 on your ParentPay account.

A guidance note on how to pre order meals on <u>will be posted on our Twitter, sent via Group call/text</u> and stored on the School website.

*Breakfasts - for any child who is in receipt of UFSM (universal free school meal) but still needs to pay for breakfasts, parents must still pay for this via ParentPay, as well as all parents who pay for meals. Breakfast choices are not available to pre-order — only lunches.
