I hope you and your families are well. We have just recently, started to gain some momentum in getting our children and staff back to school for August and whilst we do not have everything yet, set in stone, I can offer some information about our plans. Truly, we are eager to get back and see the children thrive among their friends.

August return



Officially, staff will return to work and school during the month of June. This will enable us to prepare for our children's return in August. In service days remain as 11th-12th August and children return on the 13^{th} .

The children will receive a blended model of education; a split between part time in school and Home Learning. The detail of this (e.g. two days in school and three days at home), has not been finalised. I will let you know as soon as it is more definite.

The children will be taught in groups (not whole classes), to support safe practice. The composition of the groups and the teachers assigned to each is being finalised next week by the school leadership team. There may be up to 14 learning areas/classrooms in the school to accommodate this group learning scenario.

Risk assessment, social distancing arrangements, adapted curriculum, Home Learning, ensuring that siblings attend together, etc. are all things we are currently working through.

I will send you further information on procedures for first days back when everything has been decided. This is likely to be in June, via social media, so please keep an eye out for it. I thank you for your patience and understanding.

North East Hub Lochend

The Hub will continue until 5th June. From w/c 8 June, the hubs will no longer be working and children should be supported in their own school setting. Children of keyworkers are entitled to care but if they have a partner who is working from home then similar to other keyworkers, their children should be cared for at home.

If you wish to have your child/children attend and qualify due to key worker/vulnerability status, please email me at Headteacher@ourladyofpeace-pri.glasgow.sch.uk with a few days' notice at least, as staffing levels may need to be re considered. I will send you the relevant form for completion.

These will posted this week. Please return your feedback at your convenience, even if this is August. I have included a little more detail in the feedback form and the children are to be encouraged to feedback too. It will help us self-evaluate our service to you and the children, thank you.
