

Spelling Primary 4-7

Aim: I can practise spelling words I need to know.

1. UPPER and Lower Write each of your words out two times. Write in UPPERCASE the first time and in lowercase the second time.	2. Spelling Flowers Draw a big flower. Write each of your spelling words on one of the petals!	3. Tell a Story Use all of your spelling words in a short story that makes sense! Underline your words with a ruler!	4. Adding Words Vowels (aeiou) are worth 10 points and consonants are worth 5 points. Write the word and add the value. CAT = 5 + 10 + 5 = 20
5. Curly Words First write out your words in normal writing. Next, write them again in curly letters.	6. Song Lyrics Can you find any songs, films, books or poems that have your spelling words in them?	7. Air Writing Write your words in the air with your finger. Ask someone to read your words as you write. Or ask someone to air write the letters you tell them to spell your word.	8. Cut Out Words Write your words by cutting letters out of a newspaper or magazine and gluing the letters into your jotter to spell your words.
9. Rainbow Words Write your spelling words with coloured pencils. Make each letter a different colour.	10. Join the Dots Write each of your words using dots. Then join the dots with a coloured pencil to make your word.	11. ABC Order Write your words out in alphabetical order.	12. Code Word Come up with a code for each letter of the alphabet. Write your word out once normally and once in code form. Eg: a=% b=\$ c = ☺
13. Pyramid Writing Write each of your words like a pyramid: s so som some	14. Blue Vowels Write out each of your words. Go over the vowels in each word using blue pencil.	15. Backwards Words Write your words out forwards then backwards.	16. Picture Draw a random picture. Colour the picture in using only your spelling words. How many times can you fit them in?
