Aim: I can practise spelling words I need to know.

<p>1. UPPER and Lower Write each of your words out two times. Write in UPPERCASE the first time and in lowercase the second time.</p>	<p>2. Spelling Flowers Draw a big flower. Write each of your spelling words on one of the petals!</p>	<p>3. Silly Sentences Write silly sentences with a spelling word in each sentence. Eg: My cat wears a yellow hat when she goes dancing.</p>
<p>4. Curly Words First write out your words in normal writing. Next, write them again in curly letters.</p>	<p>5. I spy! Can you find any books or songs that have your spelling words in them?</p>	<p>6. Air Writing Write your words in the air with your finger. Ask someone to read your words as you write. Or ask someone to air write the letters you tell them to spell your word.</p>
<p>7. Rainbow Words Write your spelling words with coloured pencils. Make each letter a different colour.</p>	<p>8. Join the Dots Write each of your words using dots. Then join the dots with a coloured pencil to make your word.</p>	<p>9. ABC Order Write your words out in alphabetical order.</p>
<p>10. Pyramid Writing Write each of your words like a pyramid:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">s so som some</p>	<p>11. Blue Vowels Write out each of your words. Go over the vowels in each word using blue pencil.</p>	<p>12. Cut Out Words Write your words by cutting letters out of a newspaper or magazine and gluing the letters into your jotter to spell your words.</p>
